## **What exactly can I expect when I come to Life. Documented for an engagement interview?**

You should try and show up about 15 minutes prior to your appointment. When you arrive, your interviewer will introduce him- or herself to you and your fiancé/fiancée. After this, one of you will be guided into the studio while the other remains in the lobby.

The person being filmed first will be seated. At this time, lights, sound levels, and white balance will be adjusted accordingly. The interview will begin shortly and last about twenty to thirty minutes. After the first person has finished his/her interview, he/she will swap places with his/her significant other. The process will be repeated.

## **I want to look my best. Do you have any advice?**

You will be interviewed on a black backdrop, so be sure to wear colors that contrast with black (floating heads are bad). Also, try to avoid wearing clothing that is noisy (should you be prone to fidgeting). This will be picked up on the microphone. One last thing. Skin, by its very nature, is oily. Studio lighting may cast a sheen on your face that is unwanted. Powdering before the interview will help mitigate this.

## **I want to do my best while interviewing. Do you have any suggestions?**

Relax. Review the questions you chose ahead of time and reflect on the answers; do not try and memorize them. Again, relax. You'll do fine.
